Citation Report

- Must use Web of Science to obtain Citation Report
- Include ONLY peer-reviewed articles

Scientific Output H-index

- Must use the Web of Science to obtain H-Index
- Include ONLY peer-reviewed articles
- The h-index is automatically calculated in the citation report (see above instructions)
- Each the h-index listed on the Research Summary Form
